



Donations are accepted at the discretion of the warehouse staff and/or drivers as they are most familiar with current stock levels and what sells in our Store.

All donated items should be clean, complete, and in sellable condition

- **Appliances – 15 years old max., rust & dent free, clean**
All appliances must be in 100% working order and have **ALL** parts. Freon-based appliances **MUST** be plugged in for 24 hours prior to pick-up.

- **Wood Burning Stoves** - Wood stoves. • Pellet stoves. • Wood furnaces. • Manufactured fireplaces. • Outdoor wood boilers.)

MUST be newer than the year 2000, and be certified and labeled in accordance with procedures and criteria specified in "40 C.F.R. 60 Subpart AAA - Standards of Performance for Residential Wood Heaters

- **Cabinets/Countertops – Complete, no nails/screws**

- **NO** loose drawers, doors, or individual components (except doors).
- Counter tops without cutouts. Cutout okay if it has sink.

- **Doors – Standard height (80")**

- Pre-hung or slab; interior, exterior, sliding glass (vinyl clad only), patio. Please provide keys for any locks.
- **NO** rot, cracks, or missing/cracked/fogged panes
- **NO** Garage doors.
- Storm doors must include all windows and screens, track and/or framing
- **NO** Bi-fold or shower doors. **EXCEPT** new, in box.

- **Electrical – Some commercial items may be declined**

- **Exercise Equipment: Good, working order. No Ski machines.**

- **Flooring – Nail free**

- New, unused hardwood or laminate flooring, 50 sq. ft. min. In original boxes **ONLY**.
- **NO** loose flooring
- Tile – new, unused, in box. **NO** singles.
- New carpet and/or pad (min. 100 sq. ft. and at least 4X4 ft)
- Area rugs – clean with no stains, odors, or holes

- **Furniture – Structurally sound with all parts**

- Quality upholstered furniture without stains, odors, pet hair or scratches, excessive fading or sagging, rips, tears or holes. **NO** floral or dated patterns.
- **NO** incomplete bedframes. (must have headboard/footboard/rails w/ hardware)
- **NO** coffee or end tables.
- **NO** single nightstands. (pairs only)

- Mattresses/box spring sets in “**NEW**” or “**LIKE NEW**” condition: 2 years old or less, neutral color. **NO** Sleep Number beds, RV mattresses, or solo box springs.
- **NO** “Box style” TV Cabinets.
- Dining sets (table + matching chairs) only.
- No repainted and/or handmade furniture
- Fine furniture desks only; **NO** metal, particle board, or standard office desks

- **Hardware**

- Complete sets of door hardware, hinges, etc.
- Nails, screws, hangers, connectors, etc. (**MUST** be sorted.)
- **NO** rusted or painted hardware.

- **Insulation: new and unopened**

- **Lighting – With mounting hardware (if applicable)**

- Interior or exterior lamps and light fixtures
- **NO** shop lights or tube style fixtures (except LED)
- **NO** wooden vanity lights
- New Bulbs: LED or specialty. Drop off your mercury containing bulbs for recycling (10 per day per person)

- **Lumber – Nail, screw and staple free**

- Linear lumber at least 4' long, **NO** nails.
- Sheet goods at least 4' x 4'

- **Paint/Paint Supplies**

- New, full, unopened paint/stain; less than 1 year old.
- Non-rusted cans with original labels
- Removers, brushes, rollers, trays, etc.

- **Plumbing – With all parts and hardware**

- Sinks: in good condition; **NO** rust, chips, dents or stains; white and stainless steel only. **NO** pedestal sinks.
- Bathtubs: Standard size (30" x 60") white tubs only. in good condition; **NO** rust, chips or dents. **NO** cast iron.
- Jacuzzi tubs must include all parts, motor attached.
- **NO** Shower doors.

- Toilets: Clean, assembled, working, low-flush, **NO** chips, ADA compliant (17"-19" floor to rim), elongated bowl; must include all components. White toilets only.
- Faucets: complete sets only
- Pipe: PVC/metal/copper, at least 4' long
- Miscellaneous plumbing hardware, supplies, fittings. Must be sorted.

- **Roofing – **NO** tile roofing**

- Rolls of roofing paper
- New shingles in bundles; metal roofing

- Gutter and downspout components with **NO** rust, dents or damage
- **Venting – Clean and in good condition**
 - Floor, ceiling, cold-air return venting
- **Windows – Vinyl clad, double pane only**
 - **NO** missing/cracked/ fogged glass
 - Fixed or double-hung, horizontal sliders, casement, bay/bow, storm. Complete with all sashes & handles required.

- Screens, metal or wood.
- **Mirrors/Wall Art/Glass:** framed only, unbroken
- **Shutters:** interior or exterior
- **Tools:** hand tools and working power tools, **NO** rust
- **TVs:** LCD or LED flat panels only, **MUST** have base.
- **Vehicles, boats, campers:** working, with title.
- **Wall paper:** full or almost full rolls

***Please provide pictures of assembled donations if donating them unassembled, if at all possible!**

WE DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Window blinds (unless new and in the original box)
- Coffee tables or end tables.
- Hazardous or toxic chemicals
- Tube, projection TVs (flat panel LCD or LED only)
- Soft goods (clothing, linens, etc.)
- Dishware
- Knick knacks.
- Infant items, e.g. car seats, cribs, changing tables etc.
- Sewing machines in cabinets
- Pianos (except Grand or Player) or Organs
- Copy machines
- Vehicle tires
- Alarms (CO2 or smoke detectors)
- Hospital Beds
- Asbestos or hazardous materials
- Hot tubs
- Uncertified or rusty propane tanks
- Singular China Hutches
- Books
- Garage doors

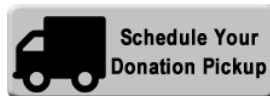
